

# Kiona Wines Win Big (Again) at the Seattle Wine Awards



After coming home with three awards in the 2009 Seattle Wine Awards last year, Kiona has outdone itself in 2010 by earning three Double Golds and a Silver for the 2010 event. The Seattle Wine Awards is the most prestigious and comprehensive independent Washington wine recognition program in the world. On April 24th and 25th, 15 of Washington's most prominent wine professionals tasted and evaluated hundreds of Washington wines in a single-blind format (meaning they knew the varietal but not the price nor producer) and awarded the top wines with Double Gold, Gold, Silver, and Bronze awards of Excellence.
