Top 100 Washington Wines 2017

Kiona Vineyards and Winery placed two wines on the annual Seattle Met Magazine Top 100 Washington Wines list. Sean Sullivan, contributing editor to Wine Enthusiast Magazine, compiled the list.

20 Best Under \$30 Category: At \$15 SRP, the 2014 Estate Red Mountain Lemberger was the least expensive wine in the category:

"Kiona has been carring the flag for Washington lemberger for decades, and seldom carried it higher than with this delicious bottle, full of ripe, polished cranberry, cherry, and dark fruit flavors."

White Wine Category: Landing at #2 on the list, the 2016 Estate Red Mountain Chenin Blanc Ice Wine added to its sterling reputation as a pinnacle example of Washington dessert wine:

"Ice Wine is a rare beast in Washington: Grapes picked in the wintertime, after they have frozen on the vine, produce a superconcentrated dessert wine, a perfect end to any dinner."
