2024 Pinot Noir + Lemberger Blend

“This may well be the only blend of these two varieties to be found in the U.S. Lighter in color, the aromas show some initial reduction. Beyond that are notes of cigar box, red fruit, and spice. The palate is medium-bodied, with plump feeling fruit flavors. A light grip of rustic tannins backs it up. It’s tasty. Give it a short decant. 13.6% alcohol. TCA-free micro-agglomerated cork. 364 cases produced.
