

Kiona wins big at the 2009 Seattle Wine Awards



"The Seattle Wine Awards is the most prestigious and comprehensive independent Washington wine recognition program in the world. On April 25th and 26th, 15 of Seattle's most prominent wine professionals tasted and evaluated 764 Washington wines in a single-blind format (meaning grape variety is known, but not the price or producer) and awarded the top wines with Double Gold, Gold, Silver and Bronze Grand awards of Excellence."
