

2019 ESTATE RED MOUNTAIN ROSÉ OF SANGIOVESE

As a category, rosé has exploded in popularity over the last 5+ years, to the point where it has been the largest growth area in the entire industry over that period. Our iteration this year is paler and more delicate than ever, and we're thrilled with how it turned out.

Sangiovese is a rarity on Red Mountain, where we have a total of 5.3 acres planted between two of our esteemed sites: Kiona Estate and Ranch at the End of the Road. With rosé we pay special attention to ripeness and pick earlier than for our red wine version, ensuring proper acid and color levels.

There's a reason Sangiovese is used to make some of the world's most famous—and delicious—rosés. The stalwart Italian grape thrives in this role, exhibiting incredible freshness, layered, nuanced texture, and beautiful color, all bouyed by food-friendly acidity. We cold-ferment this wine from start to finish, a process that preserves a lot of vibrancy (along with a slight effervescence). For friends and lovers.
