In 1975 our family planted the first vineyard on Red Mountain, an area now known for producing some of the world's most powerful, opulent wines of distinction. For three generations we've worked side by side, hand in hand to craft exciting, vineyard-driven wines that capture the essence of Red Mountain.

VINEYARD PROFILE

Emory vineyard is almost entirely planted in Syrah, and is located very close to our own Syrah planting at the estate Ranch at the End of the Road vineyard. Although we do not own Emory vineyard, are contracted to farm it and take all of the fruit. It's located high on the hill, resulting in superior air/water drainage and significant heat accumulation.

WINE PROFILE

Syrah grown on Red Mountain ripens deeply and produces plush, full wines bursting with concentrated spice, earth, and dark fruit. Our gentle oak regiment (90% neutral) ensures gorgeous color and ample minerality are preserved in bottle. The small Mourvèdre addition contributes intriguing white pepper aromatics.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2012 vintage was an exemplary year on Red Mountain. Lots of heat units ensured full ripening, with the wines showcasing ripe, round fruit characteristic and incredible balance.
