RED MOUNTAIN ORIGINALS

In 1975 our family planted the first vineyard on Red Mountain, an area now known for producing some of the world's most powerful, opulent wines of distinction. For three generations we've worked side by side, hand in hand to craft exciting, vineyard-driven wines that capture the essence of Red Mountain.



Kiona Vineyards and Winery planted our first Lemberger block in 1976. Since then, that original 1.8 acre planting has grown to 13.1 acres. Old vines tend to produce polished, suave tannin profiles, especially on Red Mountain. Lemberger is a varietal more often seen in cooler growing regions, which means ours is stouter and darker than most.

WINE PROFILE

Red Mountain Lemberger produces medium-bodied, spicy, deeply intricate wines that pair well with an wide assortment of foods. We like to describe it as Pinot Noir on steroids, as it exhibits bright red fruit and a pronounced earthy minerality; both characteristics shared with top Pinot Noir (just ramped up a few levels in intensity).



VINTAGE NOTES

2013 featured a hotter-than-usual summer truncated by an abrupt drop in temperature in mid-September. This stalled sugar development, allowing for continued flavor development and great acid retention before harvest.
